Sorry to miss your meeting. We have been traveling and have not had good email connections..

We are on the South end of Lopez (Makaye Harbor) the population density is effecting the water quality and depth of the water table. Early 70s our well would vent 6-8 feet in the air, natural artesian pressure, if one opened the well cap. Excellent, pure water. Now it has hardly pressure and is heavily saturated with H2s gas. We have had to modify our system extensively to oxygenate our water to get rid of the H2S gas. Newer wells have to go deeper. Other folks are having to upgrade their systems. I'd suspect that that we've exceed carrying capacity and the water table is being drawn down so that we are getting salt water intrusion? This should be a consideration on any increases in housing on our end of the Island.
