Subject: Pedestrian Vulnerabilities when crossing Weeks Rd to get mail

To: Adam and Members of the Lopez Area Subarea Plan Committee

I haven't yet seen the Draft plan, but I'll be interested to see whether it addresses the distinct problems that pedestrians face when crossing Weeks Rd. to get to the Post Office. This includes the folks who live in the Hamlet Cottages, as well as other pedestrians who will come through the LVM parking lot and then cross Weeks.

Auto and truck speed on Weeks are certainly an issue since Weeks is apparently the main arterial(?) for entering and leaving the Village.

Another issue would be the speed of cars and trucks entering and leaving the PO Parking Lot. I live in the Hamlet, and I've got reasonably good hearing and can scramble out of the way of a diesel truck coming out of the PO parking, but not all of my neighbors hear well, or can scramble out of the way of a car or truck whose driver is either entering or leaving the PO Parking Lot. The drivers' eyes are on the road of course, but pedestrians are often part of the landscape and may be easily overlooked. I often wave my arms to make sure I'm seen.
