This sliding fee scale applies to children through the age of 18 years who are receiving vaccine through the Vaccines For Children (VFC) program and uninsured/underinsured adults. Insured adults are asked to seek immunizations and medical services through their medical home and/or primary care provider. Those with Medicaid will be classified as Patient Status "A" with proof of enrollment.

**San Juan Count Health & Community Services (SJC HCS) began collecting fees for immunization administration and office visits beginning on June 1, 2023.**

Patients may self-attest to annual income amounts to determine patient status. Amount owed will be calculated based on patient status and services rendered. All fees are due at the time of service.

Immunization Office Visit Fee (per visit, per patient)	\$10.00
Immunization Administration Fee (per vaccine administered)	\$10.00
Pregnancy Test Fee	\$10.00
Tuberculosis (PPD) Test & Test Read Fee	\$10.00

*Cost of Vaccine: \$0 for all children through age 18 years / \$0 for all adults who are uninsured or underinsured.*
